

Join a local expert and explore the city's medieval pedestrian streets including Maria Theresian Strasse, the Hofburg and the Golden Roof. *(B)*

Make a special stop to visit Neuschwanstein Castle, Germany's most famous castle and the inspiration for the castle in *Sleeping Beauty*. Continue on to the quaint village of Oberammergau, nestled in the Bavarian Alps, and your home for the next two nights. (B, D)

Day 10: Tuesday, August 9, 2022 Oberammergau - Passion Play This afternoon, witness a performance of the epic Passion Play. The original performance dates back to 1634. During the Thirty Years' War, Oberammergau was spared the Black Plague and for this reason, the citizens vowed that every ten years they would give a play to honor the last days of the life of Christ. The performers of this once-in-a-decade event are all native to the village. To lend authenticity to the performance, the cast start to grow their hair and beards more than a year in advance. Also, the intricate costumes are made locally by the villagers. During a break in the performance, join your fellow travelers for dinner before returning for the remainder of your Passion Play performance. (B, L, D)

## Day 11: Wednesday, August 10, 2022 Oberammergau -

Munich Enjoy a leisurely morning before departing for the Bavarian capital of Munich. Join a local expert for a tour featuring the Marienplatz, the Glockenspiel and Olympic Park. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner at a local restaurant celebrating the end of an unforgettable journey. (B, D)

Day 12: Thursday, August 11, 2022 Munich - Tour Ends Your tour comes to a close today. (B)

\*Zacchera Hotels is a hotel chain in Lago Maggiore. The exact hotel to be used will be available 2 weeks prior to tour departure date.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (1-2 hours) isn't a big deal. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, Zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. You can expect some longer days balanced with free-time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. Please note, if you require a walker or wheelchair, or have difficulty walking, you may not be able to access some of these areas and may want to consider an alternate tour.

Air passengers will arrive into Milan, Italy airport and transfer to Stresa. All transfers will depart from this airport. Travel time from Milan airport to Stresa is approximately 1 hour.

Due to tour scheduling, flights must arrive prior to 4:00 p.m.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

#### Hike the Swiss Alps

Embrace a one-of-a-kind adventure on a hike through the very heart of the Swiss Alps. Breathe in the pure Alpine air while surrounded by one of the most brilliant mountain panoramas in the world, where the pyramid-shaped Matterhorn looms on the horizon. Ascend more than 10,000 feet on board Europe's highest mountain railway, through tunnels and over snow-capped peaks to Gornergrat Mountain. Step off at Rotenboden, where the Matterhorn reflects against the surface of the lake, and Italy's mountains tower in the distance. Set out on a leisurely hike over breathtaking terrain in the company of your mountain guide, who points out the varieties of flora and fauna that inhabit the mountain landscape. *Duration: Approximately 4 hours.* Please note a minimum of 10 passengers is required. #### Lake Maggiore Cruise to Isola Bella
